You have requested an advisory opinion concerning whether you can continue to serve as member of the ______Advisory Board of Directors since you been recently elected a Metropolitan Judge. You indicate that your responsibility is "to provide assistance and advice". Some members of the board assist in solicitation and raising money for the center but you have chosen not to become involved with this activity.

is a non-profit organization and emotional support for victims ______. Volunteers from this organization often testify in felony ______ cases in District Court, but these matters are not within the jurisdiction of the Metropolitan Court. Although the Metropolitan Court is authorized to conduct preliminary hearings in felony cases this very rarely occurs since most felony cases are submitted to a Grand Jury or the preliminary hearings are heard in District Court.

Your attention is directed to the "new" Code of Judicial Conduct which was approved by our Supreme Court on February 16, 1995. SCRA 21-500(C)(3) states as follows:

- (3) A judge may serve as an officer, director, trustee or non-legal advisor of an organization or governmental agency devoted to the improvement of the law, the legal system or the administration of justice or of an educational, religious, charitable, fraternal, or civic organization not conducted for profit, subject to the following limitations and other requirements of this Code:
 - (a) a judge shall not serve as an officer, director,

trustee or non-legal advisor if it is likely that the organization:

Although you have indicated that you will not engage in fund raising for the _____you might be interested in reviewing SCRA 21-500(C)(3)(b). Your attention is also directed to comments in Paragraph $\mathcal{C}(2)$ concerning use of judicial time and Paragraph C(3) prohibiting a judge from serving as a legal advisor to a civic or charitable organization.

It is therefore our opinion that serving as a board member for the _____ is not prohibited by the Code of Judicial Conduct and is provided for subject to the requirements of SCRA 21-500.
